FROM THE BLOG



Home Page (after authentication)

After a user is logged in this page will serve to deliver them aggregated content according to their level of access.

- 1 Global Navigation**
According to there level of access to the satellite sites, this will allow them to navigate between them despite what area they are visiting.
- 2 Global Account Info**
This area is for adding bookmarks, accessing a user's account and logging out.
- 3 Search**
A global, or local, search box depending on the selection in the dropdown.
- 4 Navigation**
Navigate the core site: Home, Community, Groups, etc.
- 5 Slideshow**
Slideshow or Featured Content, depending on the desire of the content management team.
- 6 Community Overview**
Featured content, recent posts, tag cloud and any additional community related content.
- 7 Group Blog**
If a member's group has their own blog, this will be featured first.
- 8 Satellite Content**
A summation of the content within all of the satellite sites (number of which depends on access).



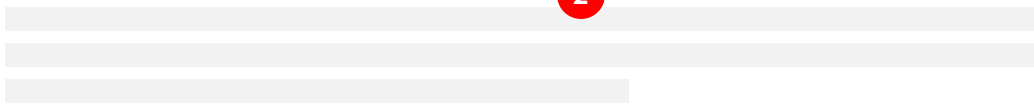

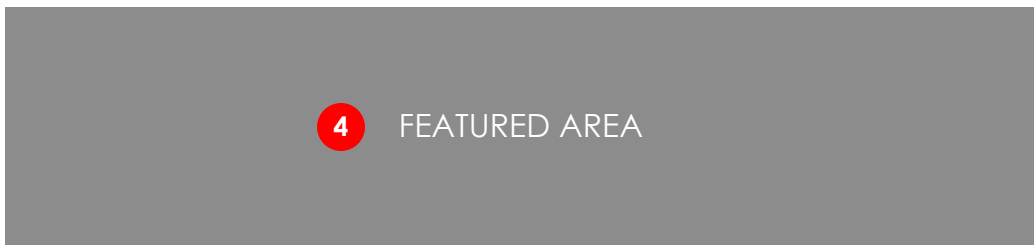

- 1 Local Navigation

- 2 Intro
The title and introductory paragraph. This could also contain a visual.
- 3 Help
Specific ad-like buttons that would help new users to learn how to effectively use this area of the site.
- 4 Featured Area
Area for content managers to showcase Activities or Topics (or other items).
- 5 Topics
A list with and accompanying image for each topic.
- 6 Blog Overview
Featured content, recent posts, tag cloud and any additional blog related content.

- 1** Introduction

- 3** About
Time it takes to perform a presentation, related materials, ect.
- 4** Presentation Area
Media player that will show a presentation, a video or a page view of the guides (or other document).
- 5** Media Browser
Allows the presenter to browse to any piece of media necessary.

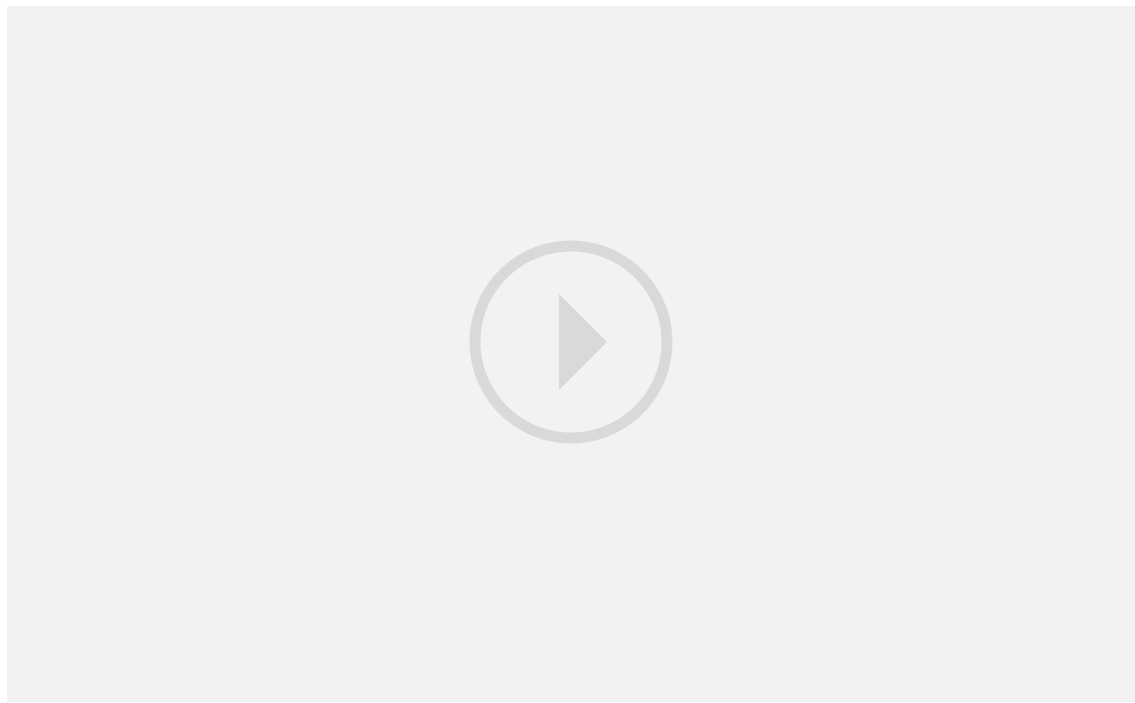
